Job Title: Water Treatment Operator Uncertified (part-time)

This part-time, non-exempt, position is the entry position into the water treatment and water production for the Authority. This role exists to help provide potable drinking water to over 10,500 customers within Anderson, Union and Campbell counties. This opportunity has the potential to become full-time in the future. Training will be provided for this role. This is a great opportunity for individuals who are looking for a start in a stable career while learning along with part-time weekend hours.

Normally Performed Duties

- Monitor computer systems and respond accordingly to alarms
- Follow all required rules of ACWA and the Tennessee Department of Conservation
- Responsible for monitoring the water treatment process
- Facility cleaning
- Record keeping
- Laboratory work as trained and as needed
- Perform other related duties as required.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS

- 2 years' general experience in utility operations
- Grade 3 State of TN water treatment license
- Some college level course work in water quality or physical sciences

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Interest in a stable career with growth potential in becoming a licensed water treatment operator
- High School Diploma or GED
- Math skills
- General knowledge of computers

JOB REQUIREMENTS

- The ability to work a flexible schedule including nights, weekends and holidays.
- The ability to work a flexible schedule when required such as staying late to complete work, coming in early and working non-traditional business hours as needed



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- The ability and agreement to work outside in all weather conditions at times to inspect or operate valves and other required activities
- The ability to work independently for long periods of time
- The ability and agreement to follow all safety procedures, work rules and policies.
- The ability to work in loud environments for extended periods of time.
- The ability to wear all the required personal protective equipment.
- The ability to obtain a Tennessee Water Treatment 3 certification within 2 years (ACWA will provide training)
- Valid Tennessee Driver License
- The ability to work in a dynamic environment
- The ability to receive instructions and act accordingly
- The ability to communicate effectively with all co-workers and supervisors

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

- The ability to work extended hours as required to assist in emergency situations
- The ability to lift, move and carry tools, equipment and parts up to 50lbs safely
- The ability to actively stand, walk and physically work during entire shifts with the ability to perform the same during extended hours.
- The ability to walk, climb and traverse stairs, walkways and at times grassy slopes or other outdoors terrain.
